## Washington College Policy for Health Requirements

All Washington College Students are required to complete and submit the following:

1. A completed *Washington College Health Form* signed by a licensed health care provider (MD, NP, PA). The date of the physical examination must be within 6 months or less of the due date of completed health forms.

2. All required immunizations – verified by the signature of a health care provider (see policy on required immunizations).

3. The student health history – to be completed by the student.

4. Emergency contact information and permission to treat form – to be completed by the student. (Parental signature may be required for students under the age of 18 as of August 20.)

5. Proof of health insurance - all students are required to demonstrate proof of health insurance or purchase the college-sponsored health insurance plan. For students who do not purchase the college-sponsored health insurance plan, a copy of the student's insurance card (front and back) must be mailed to Health Services along with the completed *Washington College Health Form*.

6. Students who do not have health insurance or do not complete the on-line waiver form will be billed for the college-sponsored health plan automatically.

7. International students must purchase the college sponsored insurance plan.

All completed forms and proof of insurance information is due on July 15<sup>th</sup> for students entering in the fall semester and January 15<sup>th</sup> for students entering in the spring semester.
