Experiential Education at Sea in the San Juan Islands, Puget Sound, WA

Program Dates - August 1st to 15th, 2014

This is a competitive program that will accept 6 students to participate in this 2-week long 4-credit experiential education experience. The program runs from August 1-15, 2014.

Rolling admissions end **March 24th**, so submit your applications early. Applications should be submitted to Professor Mark Wiest in his office in Goldstein 206, through the faculty secretary, Cindy Licata in Goldstein 224, or submitted to mwiest2@washcoll.edu (do not forget to attach your personal statement). If selected, interviews will be conducted March 25th-28th, and students will be notified of their acceptance March 31st. Trip fee and course credits total \$4200. This fee covers all field trip expenses, lodging, meals, and fees. Students are responsible for covering their own travel expenses to Gig Harbor, Washington (details included in course packet). A non-refundable \$500 program deposit is required by April 14th, 2014.
