The primary update this week is positive news – which is that we remain negative for cases of COVID! As of the end of testing yesterday, we have only one confirmed case within our campus community.

We will continue to closely monitor the situation and advise if there are any significant changes to our status.

A couple of reminders around testing. First, anyone who begins to experience ANY possible COVID symptoms – even if mild and similar to allergies – should make an appointment for testing ASAP. You can schedule COVID testing appointments through the Student Health Portal:
