Q&A – HEERF III

- **Q:** If I lost income but am now currently working, can I still be considered?
- A: Yes. You should contact Student Financial Aid.
- Q: If I lost income but it was not due to COVID-19, can I still be considered?
- A: Yes. You should contact Student Financial Aid.
- **Q:** Is funding guaranteed if my financial situation changed?
- A: No, funding cannot be guaranteed but we will do our best to make funds available to all who have had a change in their financial situation.
- **Q:** What is the amount of the award?
- A: There is not a set amount. Amounts will be determined on a case-by-case basis.
- **Q:** If I have already talked to Financial Aid and they said they couldn't help me, what are my options?
- A: If you had a conversation with them prior to this announcement, you should reach out to Financial Aid again. At the time you spoke with them, they may not have had this funding available.
- **Q:** If I have already talked to Financial Aid and adjustments have already been made, am I eligible for this funding?
- A: Yes. Contact financial aid for assistance.
- **Q:** If I am not eligible to complete a FAFSA but I have still had a change in my household financial situation, am I eligible?
- A: Yes. Contact Financial Aid and they will assist you.
- **Q:** Will this aid be offered again next year?
- A: No. This is a one-time award.
- **Q:** If I received funds previously from the Cares Act or HEERF II, am I eligible for HEERF III as well?
- A: Yes. No one is excluded from eligibility.
