#### **Executive Summary**

**PURPOSE:** The First Destinations Survey obtained information from 201 of the 209 graduates in the Class of 2024 regarding post-graduation activities. Results of the survey help us better understand outcomes including range of experiences, along with top employers and graduate/professional schools.

The information is particularly helpful to current and prospective students when considering career options. Additionally, it provides students an understanding of how academic majors can lead to various "first destinations" and pathways. In support of liberal learning, this report highlights the value of the Washington College experience and how it prepares students for lives of purpose and passion.

The report reflects outcomes data collected for nine months after graduation. As the graduates conducted job searches, they experienced a recruiting landscape reflecting an increase in virtual strategies and practices.

**METHODOLOGY:** The 2024 Cap and Gown Survey was emailed to students the week prior to graduation. Those who had not completed the survey were expected to do so during commencement rehearsal. While many reported not having firm plans, updated contact information was gathered for follow-up.

Throughout the next nine months, career center staff collected information on job searches, graduate and professional school enrollment decisions and gap year plans. By the end of February 2025, information on 201 of the 209 graduates was compiled, a 96% knowledge rate.

#### **KEY FINDINGS:**

- ➤ Based on knowledge rate, 95% of the class was either employed or continuing education.
- > 75% of the respondents were employed full-time or part-time.
- ➤ 20% of the respondents were enrolled or pursuing advanced study: 18% in graduate schools, 1% in Health Professions Schools and 1% in Law Schools.
- ➤ 1% of the respondents were categorized as "Other" which included those accepted to graduate school and deferred, volunteer work, self-directed endeavors, and travel. In addition, this category includes those not seeking employment or continuing education at this time.
- Of the 150 employed graduates, 95% (143) provided information on starting locations. 44% of those employed accepted positions in Maryland including the District of Columbia.

- ➤ 26% of those employed accepted positions in PA/DE/VA and 9% accepted positions in NJ/NY.
- Employed graduates, reporting starting location, accepted positions in 20 states and the District of Columbia.
- ➤ Top ranking employers: Washington College, Echo Hill Outdoor School, JPMorgan Chase & Co., AmeriCorps, FEMA, Kent County Public Schools, Maryland Department of Natural Resources and National Institutes of Health.
- ➤ Top Graduate/Professional schools: University of Maryland (7), Drexel University (3), American University (2), Johns Hopkins University (2), and Temple University (2).
- ➤ Based on responses from those employed, 33% of the class obtained their employment through alumni connections, career center resources, faculty/staff, or internship/externship connections. Another 22% reported obtaining positions through family and/or friend connections.
- ➤ 4% of the class was still seeking employment opportunities at the conclusion of the data collection.



**Continuing Education:** includes graduate degrees, post-baccalaureate programs, additional undergraduate degrees, teaching certifications, and other certifications.


