Goldstein Outdoor Classroom (1)

Vibrant roses overlook a peaceful fountain statuary.

Lit House Secret Garden (N)
An enclosed garden and pergola for plays and poetry readings.

Corsica Hollow (F)
A brick patio and dense sets the stage for perfect picnics.

A cozy area with benches amid a serene palette of plants.
